## Guidelines for Owner Certification of Smoke & Carbon Monoxide Alarms Compliance

- The "Owner Certification of Smoke & Carbon Monoxide Alarm Compliance" form can be used on permitted projects where alarms are required and the work is such as re-roofing, re-siding, patio covers, decks, swimming pools and similar exterior only projects.
- The completed form shall be signed by the property owner. Forms signed by tenants, contractors, relatives, etc., will not be accepted.
- The owner shall legibly print their name and sign in the spaces provided.
- The completed form shall be submitted to the inspector by final inspection.
- In the case where the form is the only remaining correction notice item for final inspection, the completed form may be either emailed to the building division or submitted to the public permit counter during regular business hours. Email addresses can be found on the website listed above.
- If you wish to have the job card signed off, you may bring the card to the
  public counter, but this is not required for the completion of the permit
  process as long as the inspector has received the compliance form.
- Once the completed form is received and attached to the permit in the database the permit will be finaled by the inspector and the permit process is completed.
